Visit ASAP a US Post Office with or without an appointment, bring your printed on-line application, a current 2 x 2 color of student and an official long form Birth Certificate and check. Approx. wait time 2-4 weeks. **Please make a color copy of your Birth Certificate prior to submitting it with Passport application** in the event it doesn't arrive in time it along with your passport receipt serves as proof of completion.

The trip includes:

- Six days of food & lodging at Calvary Chapel SQ
- Transportation via bus.
- One night's stay at a private beach
- Adult to student supervision a ratio of 1 to 8.
- Building & children educational supplies.
